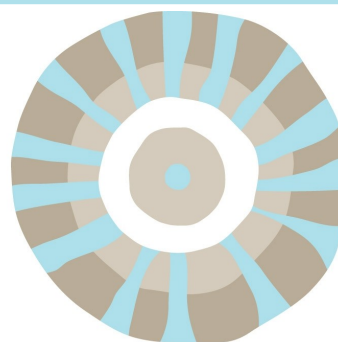

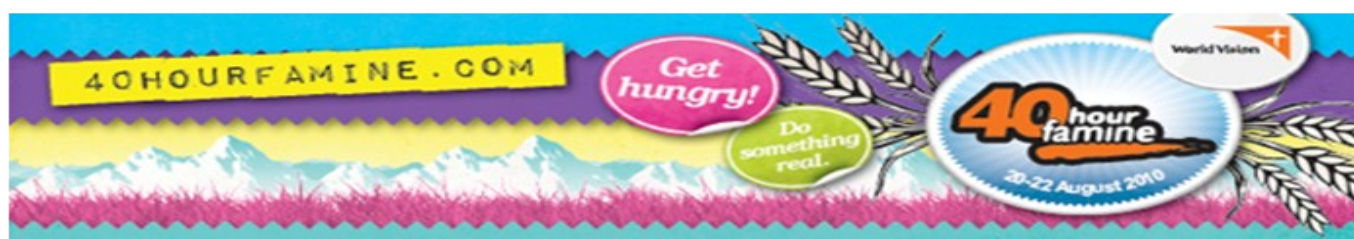

Intervention (including information about the previous 40 Hour Famine Project)

- Between 2007-2009 the WVA 40 Hour Famine funded a food security and nutrition program (Hamutuk Hadia Nutrisaun) that worked across three districts in Timor-Leste
- The purpose of the project was to decrease malnutrition rates in children through increasing the production of food, improving nutrition practices amongst caregivers and increasing health access.
- Mothers in the community with healthy children shared nutrition information and local cooking skills with mothers' who had malnourished children

Achievements

- An evaluation of the project found at least 87% of farmers experienced an increase in production through using improved practices and improved varieties of seed
- The nutrition knowledge and behavioral practices of care givers improved so that 77% of children were fed foods from at least three of the four main food groups over a 24 hour period.
